

The Art Gallery

The Art Gallery stages art, cultural history and civic information exhibitions. Exhibitions, concerts and other cultural events are held all round the year. It also houses the Creative Workshop and a multivision unit for slide presentations and art videos.

Educational activities

Children and young people are also welcome to the Art Gallery – pre-school children and school classes often pay a visit. Accompanied by a trained educationalist, they tour the current exhibition and try out their skills in the Creative Workshop. They can also see and experience art first-hand through the travelling exhibitions produced for daycare centres and schools.



Cafés

Café Blå, by the adults' section of the library, looks out over Stora Torget and the Old City Hall. The café serves coffee, tea, soft drinks, sandwiches, cakes and pastries.

Café Nova is in Lunagallerian opposite the library's newspapers and magazines department. The café, with its low prices, two stages and opportunities for cultural expression in the Creative Workshop, is primarily intended for young people over 16. In other words, culture both for and by young people, who can help make the decisions as they wish.

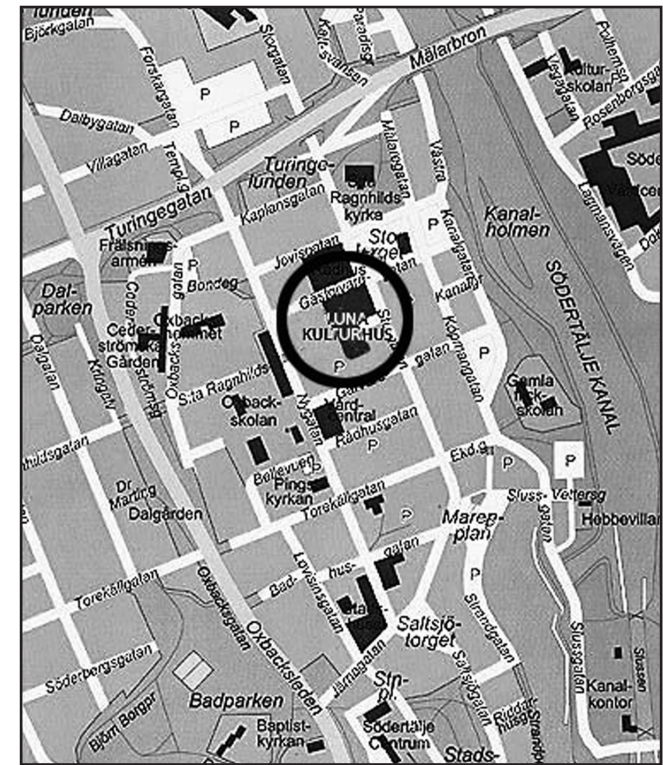

Welcome to LUNA KULTURHUS

Luna Kulturhus is a meeting place for everyone and is situated right in the centre of town on the Lunagallerian mezzanine. Take the escalator or lift up to the entrance, where you'll find the issuing counter, an information service and the Luna Ticket Centre.



Luna Kulturhus stands on three legs: **the Puplic library, the Art Gallery and Café Nova**. Its activities are governed by the Södertälje Cultural and Leisure Committee.

The Puplic Library

The Puplic library has a wide variety of books, newspapers and magazines in several languages. Here you'll find everything from detective novels and other fiction to encyclopaedias, dictionaries and language courses. You can also borrow films, music and books on CD. Talking books on CD – known as DAISY – are available for people with reading impairments. If you'd like to listen to a DAISY book, you can borrow a special DAISY player from the Library.

To borrow or reserve a book or to book a computer, you need a **library card**. Library card are free.

At our website, <http://opac.sodertalje.se>, you can search the library's catalogue, reserve media, see what you have borrowed and renew your loan. To do so, you'll need a **PIN code**, which you can get from us. No charge is made if you want to use the Internet or a word processor.

If you're a student, you can obtain access to a special study room or group room. During term, the library can also organise help with your homework.

The newspaper department has its own entrance in the mornings and opens as early as 8.00 a.m. Not during the summer, though – see our website for details!

If you need any help, don't hesitate to ask the staff.



Junior department

Read, listen, search, borrow!

For our youngest visitors, there are picture books and books of nursery rhymes and stories of all sorts. The first on the shelves of children's "chapter books" are the "Starting-to-Read Books".

The young people's books also begin with an "Easy Readers" section.

If you'd like some tips on good books or want to borrow one of our computers, visit <http://opac.sodertalje.se> (you'll find the children's catalogue in the margin on the left).

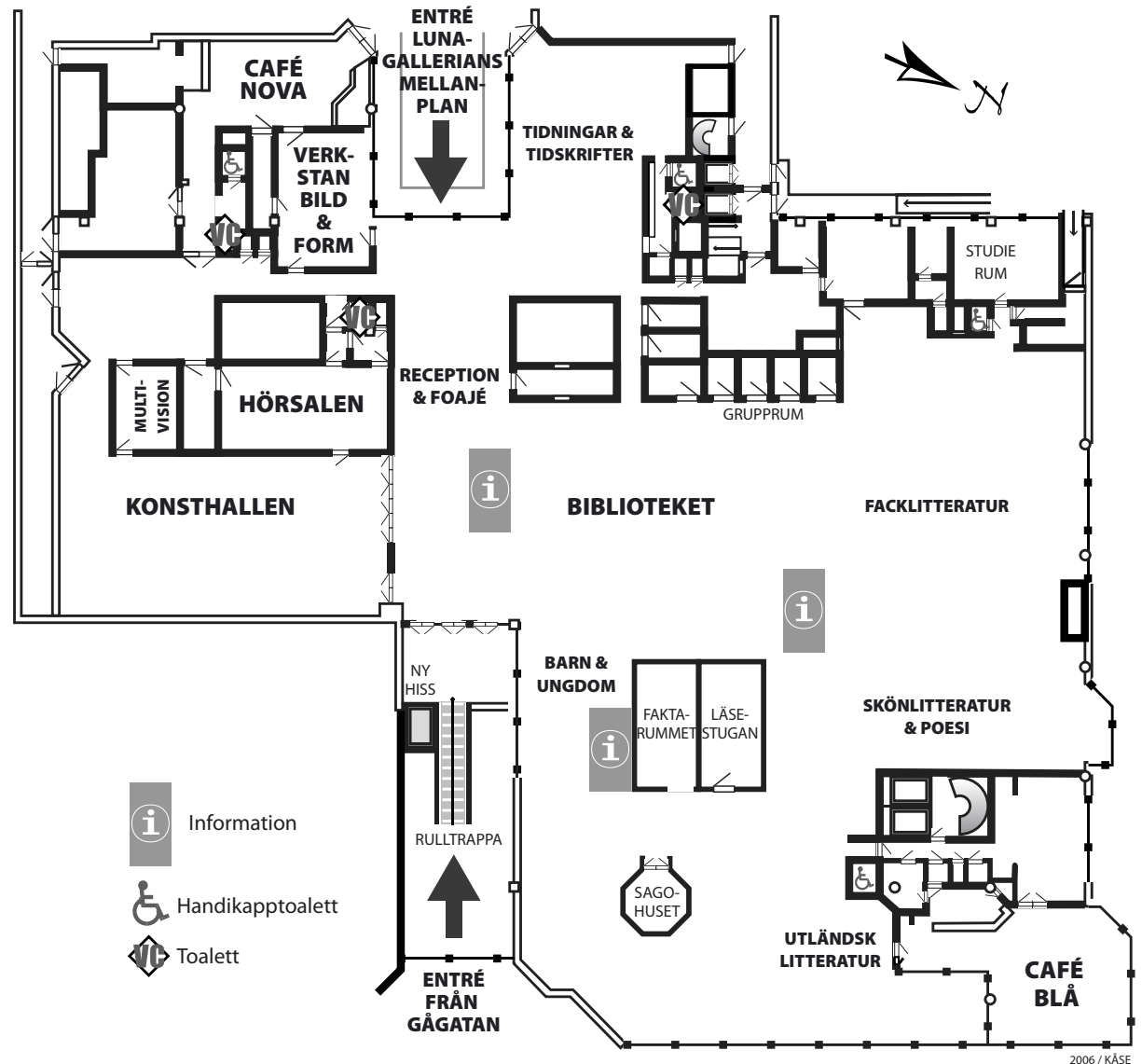
You can also borrow computer games, CD books and talking books on tape. Books on special subjects are in a room of their own.

Computers are available for looking for books, for games and surfing the Net. You will need a library card (except for looking for books).

Programmes (almost) all year round

For the youngest children, there are storytelling sessions, nursery rhymes and rhythmical games in the Fairytale House from Monday to Friday (except during the summer). Special programmes are organised for schoolchildren during the autumn, sports and Easter holidays.

Book loans and participation in programmes are free of charge.
